Stamp Sets: Way to Goat (152657)

Inks: Bumblebee (153116); Tuxedo Black Memento (132708)

Paper: Old Olive cardstock (100702); Cinnamon Cider cardstock (153078); Basic White cardstock (159276); Basic White Thick cardstock (159229); Ornate Garden Specialty Designer Series Paper (152488)

Other: Bumblebee Gingham Ribbon (153658); Tasteful Labels Dies (152886); Mini Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (150673); Paper Snips Scissors (103579); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); Stampin' Blends Combo Pack in the following colours – Cinnamon Cider (153105) Crumb Cake (154882); Old Olive (154892); Daffodil Delight (154883)

Measurements:

- Basic White Thick: 4 ¼" x 5 ½" scored in half for card base
- Old Olive: 4x 5 ¼"
- Ornate Garden Specialty Designer Series Paper: 3 ¾" x 2" green pattern: 3 ¾" x 3" yellow pattern
- Cinnamon Cider: approx. 2"x4" for die cut
- Basic White: approx. 2"x4" for die cut; approx. 2"x3" for goat

Instructions:

1. Stamp the goat with memento black ink onto the basic white.
2. Use the Tasteful Label dies and the Mini Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine to cut out a Cinnamon Cider and a Basic White label as shown. Stamp the sentiment on the left side of the Basic White label with the Bumblebee inkpad.
3. Cut the Cinnamon Cider label in half. Adhere to the underside of the Basic White die cut label to add an outline as shown.
4. Adhere the Ornate Garden Specialty Designer Series Paper to the Old Olive cardstock as shown.

5. Adhere the Bumblebee Gingham ribbon to hide the seam where the two patterned papers meet.
6. Adhere the Old Olive layer onto the Thick Basic White card base.
7. Use a variety of Stampin' Blends to colour the goat as shown. Cut out carefully with the Paper Snips
8. Use Stampin' dimensionals to adhere the die cut labels. Centre on the ribbon. Use Stampin' dimensionals to adhere the goat to the right side of the label.
